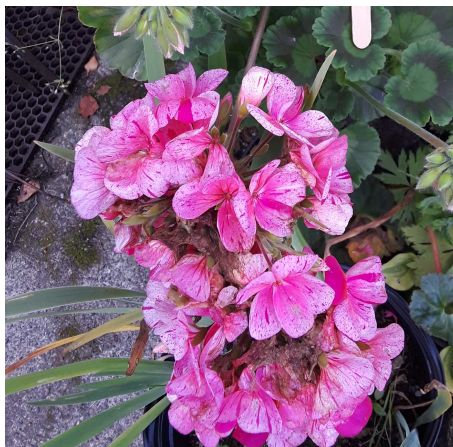

**Application for renewal of good standing:**  
 To obtain refresher credit, Judges must attend all lectures in their entirety, including oral point scoring sessions. Any Judge expecting credit for this symposium must send completed appropriate form at least 30 days in advance of Symposium plus any other required materials to the registrar.

Accredited Judge – Form 13E – Each renewal may be taken by an Accredited Judge two years from the date of accreditation or the last renewal providing the proper number of exhibiting and judging credits has been obtained. Master and Life – Form 15E .

**Important:** Judges taking the Point Scoring Examination will be seated in the first rows.  
**They should bring clipboard and pencils for the point scoring.**
